Summary of Events

Alarms:

Deputies responded to 5 alarms that were cleared as false alarms.

Contract Checks:

Deputies conducted 54 combined contract and miscellaneous checks during the month

Traffic Enforcement:

Deputy conducted numerous traffic stops and traffic initiatives throughout the contract during the month in the interest of public safety and in an attempt to reduce the risk of motor vehicle accidents.

19600 Timber Forest Dr – Deputy conducted a traffic stop for expired registration. Investigation revealed the driver to be driving while license invalid and having no insurance. The driver was arrested for DWLI and booked into the Harris County Jail.

Assault:

5800 Upper Lake Dr – Deputy responded to an assault call. Investigation revealed children were playing football at the school after hours and engaged in a mutual combat fight. Both children and both parents were interviewed and charges were declined by the District Attorney's Office.

Theft Other:

5700 Green Timbers Dr – Deputy responded to a theft other type call. Investigation revealed unknown suspect(s) stole drain covers from the public roadway and fled undetected. Deputy remained on scene until Pct 2 road and bridge employees responded to cover the holes.

Family Disturbance:

19700 Burle Oaks Ct – Deputy responded to a family disturbance call. Investigation revealed family members engaged in a family disturbance regarding child custody. The matter was civil in nature and no charges were filed. CPS was notified and a report completed.

Other Calls:

19700 River Brook Ct – Deputy responded to a disturbance call. Investigation revealed the homeowner's son was playing a video game in which the audio was loud enough to cause the reporter concerned that there was an altercation inside the residence but it was only the game.

19500 Alinawood Dr – Deputy responded to a meet the citizen call. Investigation revealed the homeowner requested a report to satisfy an insurance claim for a leaking roof. There was no evidence that a crime had been committed.

5600 Enchanted Timbers Dr – Deputy responded to a welfare check. Investigation revealed a juvenile left the residence without permission and was believed to be a danger to herself. She was located at a local business and taken to the hospital for an emergency detention order without incident.
