Summary of Events

Alarms:

Deputies responded to 4 alarm call.

Checks:

Deputies conducted a total of 81 combined park checks, neighborhood checks, and other miscellaneous checks.

Traffic Enforcement:

Deputies conducted numerous traffic stops and traffic initiatives throughout the contract during the month in the interest of public safety, and in an attempt to reduce the risk of motor vehicle accidents.

5900 Upper Lake Dr – Deputy conducted a traffic stop. Investigation revealed the driver was in

possession of marijuana. The District Attorney's Office does not accept charges for marijuana possession and the driver was placed on their marijuana diversion program.

Family Disturbance:

5500 Green Timbers Dr – Deputy responded to a family disturbance call. Investigation revealed family members engaged in a physical altercation that ended without injury. The District Attorney's Office declined charges.

19500 Oak Station Dr – Deputy responded to a family disturbance call. Investigation revealed family members had a verbal altercation. Parties were separated for the night.

SUSPICIOUS PERSON:

Contract Patrol deputies responded to 7 suspicious persons within the community. All these scenes were utilized to gather intelligence and were all cleared without incident after thorough investigations.

SUSPICIOUS VEHICLES:

Contract patrol deputies responded to 4 suspicious vehicles within the community. All these scenes were utilized to gather intelligence and were all cleared without incident after thorough investigations.

Runaway:

5400 Forest Timbers Dr – Deputy responded to a runaway call. Investigation revealed juvenile left home without permission. The juvenile was located and returned home.

Telephone Harassment:

5600 Green Timbers Dr – Deputy responded to a telephone harassment call. Investigation revealed the complainant was receiving unwanted phone calls and text messages from an unknown person.

Other:

19400 Atasca Oaks Dr – Deputy responded to a meet the citizen call. Investigation revealed complainant was driving on FM 1960 when an unknown object struck his window and damaged it. The complainant drove home to file a report. This incident occurred outside of contract.

19700 Big Timber Dr – Deputy responded to a credit card abuse call. Complainant reported her credit card information was used to make unauthorized transactions without her consent.

19400 Atasca Oaks Dr - Deputy responded to a credit card abuse call. Complainant reported his credit card information was used to make unauthorized transactions without his consent.

19600 Spoonwood Dr – Deputy responded to a fraud call. Investigation revealed a suspect used the complainant's information to make fraudulent charges.

19300 Timber Forest Dr – Deputy responded to a disturbance call. Investigation revealed two males had an argument over a dog walking in a yard.

5700 Enchanted Timbers Dr – Deputy responded to a welfare check. Reporter observed a child ring her door bell. Deputy made contact with residence where child was and confirmed everything was okay.

5400 Forest Timbers Dr – Deputy responded to a computer crime call. Investigation revealed a parent discovered inappropriate activity on their juvenile son's computer. The computer was placed into evidence and the case was referred to our High Tech Crimes Division for follow up.
