Summary of Events

Theft Vehicle

19400 Climbing Oaks Dr – Deputy responded a Stolen Vehicle call. Investigation revealed that unidentified suspect(s) stole a parked vehicle from the complainant's driveway. The vehicle was recovered several days later at another location via GPS tracking from the complainant. The juvenile suspect was not charged for the original Theft due to being unable to determine if the

subject had knowledge that the vehicle was stolen, but did resist officers on scene. Subject was arrested and booked for Resisting Arrest under a different case number. Report completed.

Theft Other

19200 Merrillwood Dr – Deputy responded to a Theft/Other call at listed address. Investigation revealed that unidentified suspects stole the tires and rims from the complainant's vehicle. Footage obtained did not yield any viable leads at this time. Report completed.

Family Disturbance:

19700 Oak Briar Dr – Deputy responded to a Family Assault call at the listed location. Investigation revealed that family members were involved in a mutual combat assault against each other. No charges filed. Report completed.

Criminal Mischief

5900 Gnarled Oaks Ct – Deputy responded to a Criminal Mischief at the listed location. Investigation revealed that known suspect intentionally caused damage to the complainant's items. Harris County DA's office accepted charges, and a warrant will be issued for the subject's arrest. Report completed.

19500 Oak Timbers Dr – Deputy responded to a Criminal Mischief at the listed location. Investigation revealed that a possibly known suspect intentionally caused damage to the complainant's items, as well as property belonging to The Oaks HOA. Suspect leads obtained, and investigation is pending. Report completed.

Runaway

5600 Forest Timbers Dr – Deputy responded to a Runaway call at the listed address. Investigation revealed that a juvenile left the residence without the effective consent of their parent, and has not yet returned. Report completed.

Other

19700 Big Timber Dr – Deputy responded to an Animal Humane call. Investigation revealed that the reportee believed there was a dog being mistreated at another address located in Atascocita North. Case was referred to animal control/SPCA. Report completed.

19600 Merrillwood Dr – Deputy responded to a (delayed) Fraudulent Use of ID call at the listed address. Investigation revealed that unknown suspect(s) used the complainant's identity to open an AT&T account 5 years prior. Report completed.

DISTURBANCE OTHER

Contract patrol deputies responded to 2 disturbances involving adults, within the community. All calls were handled without incident and dispersed accordingly while gathering intelligence for safety of the contract.

ALARMS

Contract patrol deputies responded to 6 local alarms at various locations within the community. They were handled without incident and were all found to be false alarms.

SUSPICIOUS PERSON

Contract Patrol deputies responded to 3 suspicious persons within the community gathering intelligence while identifying potential problems. All persons were cleared without incident.

SUSPICIOUS VEHICLES

Contract patrol deputies responded to 7 suspicious vehicles within the community. All these scenes were utilized to gather intelligence and were all cleared without incident after thorough investigations.

TRAFFIC

Contract patrol deputies made multiple traffic stops, enforcing the traffic laws of the state of Texas, within the contract reducing the possibility of accidents and lessening the chance of repeat offenders in the patrolled areas.
